

Executive Summary for 2022

- Membership numbers are top 5 worldwide with ~40% paying
- **IN-BOARD Nordic Academy continued success** ramping up Nordic collaboration (for the 7th consecutive year, educating alumni for Board positions)
- Event quality high, Summer Party and Energy Club success (continue building on the success of social events and will be enhanced going forward)
- **Positive financial result** in 2022 mainly driven by more members and fewer in-person events than budgeted for
- **Digitalization of financial back-office processes** on payment and accounting




INSEAD scholarship for Norwegian students


